**TEXAS ENERGY ASSOCIATION FOR MARKETERS’  
MOTION TO AMEND ITS INTERVENOR STATUS**

The Texas Energy Association for Marketers (TEAM) files this motion to amend its intervenor status and respectfully request that the REP Coalition, consisting of TEAM and the Alliance for Retail Marketers (ARM), be granted party status in this proceeding.

**I. BACKGROUND**

On January 31, 2025, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint) filed an application for approval of its proposed system resiliency plan (the Application). Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.62(d)(1) this motion is timely filed on or before the 30th day after the date service of notice was complete.

**II. AMENDED MOTION TO INTERVENE**

The REP Coalition seeks to participate in this proceeding pursuant to 16 TAC §§ 22.103 and 22.104. The members of the REP Coalition participating in this proceeding are retail electric providers certificated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas to provide retail electric service in regions of Texas within the Electric Reliability Council of Texas, which includes CenterPoint’s service territory. Although CenterPoint has indicated that it will not seek to utilize a resiliency cost recovery rider, REP Coalition members will nevertheless be responsible for the implementation and payment of any charges resulting from the recovery of the investment made pursuant to the system resiliency plan approved in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, the REP Coalition has a justiciable interest that may be adversely affected by the outcome of this proceeding and should be granted party status.
