**SOAH ORDER NO. 4
GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE; DISMISSING
CASE FROM SOAH; REMANDING CASE TO COMMISSION**

On May 28, 2025, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor), Delaware Basin Midstream LLC (DBM), and Commission Staff (Staff) (collectively, the Parties) filed Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand to the Commission based on a Unanimous Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Stipulation). As there are no other parties to this proceeding and no remaining disputed issues of fact or law, the motion is well-taken and **GRANTED**.
