GRANT DARNELL'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO ENTERGY TEXAS, INC.

General Instructions

- In responding to each request, please provide information available from all corporate and individual files, as well as from all past and present contractors, staff, employees, officers, and board members and all predecessors and affiliates, as defined below.
- 2. These requests are continuing in nature and require supplemental responses in accordance with 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.144(i).
- 3. If any information is not available in the exact form requested, provide whatever information or documents that best respond to the request.
- 4. If any request appears unclear or ambiguous, please contact Grant Darnell as soon as possible to obtain clarification.
- 5. Each document of one page or more should include
 - a. full name and address of the author(s) who wrote and or prepared
 - b. date of the document
 - c. title and subject of the document
 - d. name and address of every recipient of the document
 - e. be bound, and the individual pages numbered consecutively
- 6. When the recipient of the RFI is requested to provide an estimation, study, schedule, or analysis, it should also provide the workpapers, underlying facts, inferences, suppositions, estimates, and conclusions necessary to support each study, schedule, or analysis.
- 7. If the actual data is unavailable, but estimates or approximations are available, provide the estimates or approximations that are the best available information and explain the procedure for developing the information supplied.
- 8. If the document has been lost, shredded, or destroyed (whether intentionally or unintentionally), an explanation of the reasons for and causes of such loss, shredding or destruction.

- 9. If any requested information or document cannot be provided in its entirety, it shall be provided to the greatest extent possible, with an indication of the portion of the information or document that cannot be provided and the reason it cannot be provided.

DEFINITIONS

"ETI" refers to Entergy Texas, Inc.

"Staff" refers to, for purposes of these RFIs, the Staff of the ETI and its contractors, employees, members, officers, directors, agents, attorneys, consultants, and all persons acting under contractual arrangements with, or purporting to act on its behalf.

"Date" shall detail the exact day, month, and year of creation and / or edited and / or changed.

The terms "document" or "documents" are used in their broadest sense to include, all written or graphic matter of every kind and description, whether printed, produced, or reproduced by any process, whether visually, magnetically, mechanically, electronically, or by hand, whether final or draft, original or reproduction, whether or not claimed to be privileged or otherwise excludable from discovery, and whether or not in your actual or constructive possession, custody, or control.

"Document" or "documents" shall also include every copy of a document where the copy contains any commentary, footnote or notation of any kind that does not appear on the original or any other copy. 

DARNELL REQUEST 2-01

Please consider an alteration to Segment 35 within in Routes 25, 34, and Intervenor proposed Routes 35, 37, 38, 40, 41, 42 and 43, by turning approximately 45 degrees at a point approximately 900 feet from the second (2nd) turn on Segment35. See result of the proposed turn outlined in Blue on Attachment 1 and the kml file accompanying this RFI filing.

- The proposed turn eliminates one (1) tower, located at the corner of ETI's proposed Segment 35 and 38, by cutting the corner.
- Please provide ETI's best available estimate of the alternative Segment 35 in the same format as Table 4-2 Environmental and Land Use Data for Primary Route Evaluation, which is contained in ETI's CCN, Item 2, Attachment 1 Table 4-2 on pages 155 to 189 of 600, for Segments ExA thru 293.
- Please confirm ETI's best available cost estimate for this alternative to Segment 35 if the turn (cutting the corner) eliminates one (1) tower.
- If Entergy is not willing to construct its proposed transmission line on this alternative segment, please explain in detail why not.
