## CENTERPOINT ENERGY HOUSTON ELECTRIC, LLC'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC ("CenterPoint Houston") respectfully files this Proposed Procedural Schedule. CenterPoint Houston has conferred with Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission Staff") as well as the intervenors, Mr. Michael Engelhart and Mr. Irwin Dreyfus. CenterPoint Houston and Commission Staff have agreed to the schedule and additional provisions set out below. Mr. Engelhart did not agree with the proposal, and Mr. Dreyfus has not responded to CenterPoint Houston's communications regarding the schedule.

CenterPoint Houston proposes the modifications to discovery deadlines set out below to facilitate timely responses that support the condensed schedule necessitated by the statutory 180-day deadline in this proceeding. These adjustments are in line with past practice in other Certificate of Convenience and Necessity proceedings. These adjustments are intended to ensure that all parties receive responses to their requests with sufficient time to incorporate them into their testimony or preparations for the hearing on the merits. Their asymmetry reflects the time between the deadlines and testimony due dates and the greater scale of discovery typically propounded upon applicants like CenterPoint Houston. Accordingly, CenterPoint Houston, Commission Staff and intervenors respectfully request that the Administrative Law Judge enter an order establishing such schedule and adopting the provisions below.

- 1. For written discovery on CenterPoint Houston direct testimony:
  - a. Responses are due within ten business days of the RFI;
  - b. Objections are due within five business days of the RFI;
  - c. Motions to compel are due within three business days of an objection; and
  - d. Responses to motions to compel are due within three business days of the motion to compel.
- 2. For written discovery on intervenor and Staff direct testimony:
  - a. Responses are due within three business days of the RFI;
  - b. Objections are due within three business days of the RFI;
  - c. Motions to compel are due within two business days of an objection; and
  - d. Responses to motions to compel are due within two business days of the motion to compel.
- For written discovery on CenterPoint Houston rebuttal testimony and Staff and intervenor cross-rebuttal testimony:
  - a. Responses are due within three business days of the RFI;
  - b. Objections are due within three business days of the RFI;
  - c. Motions to compel are due within two business days of an objection; and
  - d. Responses to motions to compel are due within two business days of the motion to compel.

- 4. Service will be by the PUC Interchange System; however, if a filing requires the action of another party, service on that party is required.
- 5. Email service is a valid method of service on a party from which action is required.
- 6. CenterPoint Houston will provide an electronic document repository for the parties' prehearing submissions. Uploading hearing exhibits to CenterPoint Houston's document repository system constitutes sufficient service of the exhibits to all parties. The parties are not required to serve every party with their exhibits.
