## SOAH ORDER NO. 7

## CANCELING ROUTE-ADEQUACY HEARING

Having reviewed Hijo de Playa, LLC's, requests for a route-adequacy hearing and its position statement, CenterPoint Houston's response, and Commission Staff's motion to cancel the route-adequacy hearing, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) has determined that Hijo de Playa's arguments<sup>1</sup> implicate issues for the merits rather than "route adequacy" as the Commission uses that term, *i.e.*, the adequacy

of the number of routes proposed in CenterPoint Houston's application.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, the route-adequacy hearing presumptively scheduled by SOAH Order No. 5 for Monday, June 16, 2025, is **cancelled**.
