ORDER NO.2

REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT OF POSITION

This Order addresses the April 21, 2025 formal complaint of Regis Leakey LLC, Regis Medina LLC, Regis Medina Lake LLC, and Regis Utopia LLC (the Regis entities) against Bandera Electric Cooperative, Inc. regarding four interconnection agreements. In their formal complaint, the Regis entities requested a good cause waiver of the Commission informal resolution requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) 22.242(c)(2) (informal resolution requirements).

On May 12, 2025, Bandera Electric filed its response to the formal complaint and a motion to dismiss the formal complaint.

On May 19, 2025, the Regis entities filed a response to Bandera Electric's motion to dismiss.

On May 22, 2025, Commission Staff filed its statement of position on the formal complaint. In its statement of position, Commission Staff stated that it makes no recommendation with regard to the Regis entities' request for a good cause waiver of the informal resolution requirements.

Under 16 TAC § 22.242(c)(2), the waiver of the Commission's informal resolution requirements may be granted by Commission Staff, not the administrative law judge. Accordingly, by June 6, 2025, Commission Staff must state whether it grants or denies the Regis entities request for a waiver of the informal resolution requirements.

Bandera Electric's motion to dismiss will be addressed in a future order.
