ORDER NO. 1
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT AND REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF'S
RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

On May 15, 2025, Catalyze Pasadena 10585 Red Buff Road Microgrid, LLC filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.109 to register as a 2.4-megawatt solar facility.

On May 28, 2025, Commission Staff filed a memorandum recommending that Catalyze Pasadena's application be found deficient. Commission Staff further recommended that Catalyze Pasadena be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies in its application and provided, with specificity, the information needed for Catalyze Pasadena to cure the deficiencies, consistent with 16 TAC § 25.109(c) and (e).

The administrative law judge finds Catalyze Pasadena's application deficient for the reasons specified in Commission Staff's May 28, 2025 memorandum. Under 16 TAC § 25.109(g)(1), if the deficiencies are not cured within 20 days of the date of this Order, the application will be rejected, without prejudice to refiling.

On May 29, 2025, Catalyze Pasadena filed supplemental information.

Therefore, by June 6, 2025, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on Catalyze Pasadena's application.
