Statement of Protest:

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to formally protest the proposed water rate increases outlined in PUCT Docket No. 58124 by Aqua Texas. As a residential customer, I currently use approximately 7,200 gallons of water per month and am facing a projected monthly increase from \$47.45 to \$77.19 — a 63% rise. This represents an additional \$356.88 annually, which I find excessive and unjustified.

While I understand the need for infrastructure investment and maintenance, the magnitude of this increase — particularly the sharp hike in volumetric charges from \$3.70 to as high as \$15.12 per 1,000 gallons — is disproportionate to inflation and current household budget constraints. Many ratepayers, including myself, are already dealing with high costs of living, and such a steep increase would cause unnecessary financial hardship.

I urge the Commission to reject or significantly revise this proposal in favor of a more reasonable and phased approach that balances infrastructure needs with fairness and affordability.
