# Notice of Proposed Rate Change

has filed a rate change application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission or PUCT). The application may be reviewed online at [interchange.puc.texas.gov](http://interchange.puc.texas.gov). You may also inspect a copy of the rate change application at your utility's office at the address below or at the Commission's office (1701 N. Congress Ave, Austin, TX 78701). The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. If the Commission receives a sufficient number of protests, separately or in a combined protest letter, from at least 7,897 ratepayers (10 percent of the utility's customers over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction) or from any affected municipality before the 91st day after the proposed effective date, the matter will be set for hearing. **EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED INCREASE:** July 25, 2025

The proposed rate change is being requested in order to recover capital investments Aqua Texas has made to maintain and improve its systems since the last rate case(s) and to reflect inflationary increases to Aqua Texas' operating costs.


Ratepayer comments/request to intervene

When we purchased our home in June, 2021, we were told that our water rates would be reduced over time as more homes were added to the development and the cost of water rates were absorbed by new owners lowering our costs.

This has proven to be not true even as more homes have been built and our rates keep increasing and the water quality has deteriorated to the point where we had to add a soft water system to reduce the water hardness and corrosion of our fixtures. We have also had grains of sand and small stones lodging in our bathtub water cartridges.

These are the highest water rates that I have paid in the many years of property ownership and now another rate increase has been proposed. To my mind, this borders on criminal extortion by Aqua that I feel powerless to have any control over. This company needs to be reined in and reduce there exorbitant charges.
