Aqua Water has consistently provided subpar water service. Every spring, summer and fall, I have regular occasions of low to almost no water pressure. I and my neighbors have come to expect this unfortunately. Additionally, Aqua has failed to meet their state required water testing standards for bacterium multiple years, most recently in both 2024 and 2025.

Finally, I have an autoimmune disease and Aqua has been late on issuing boil notices 3 years in a row! This is very dangerous for me yet nothing changes! How and why is this allowed to continue?

Aqua should be required to lower their rates and provide basic water service, only after a long period of solid service should any increase be considered.
