How to Read the Index of Pages (Table of Contents)

Attached is a copy of the Notice of Proposed Rate Change as required by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT). Please review this notice carefully, as it provides additional information about Aqua Texas' request and the processing of our application by the PUCT. Below is more information outlining how to read and understand this notice for your service area.

Step 1: Identify your System and Rate Comparison: Locate your water or sewer system on pages 5-22. Water Systems are listed on pages 5-19 and sewer systems are listed on pages 20-22. The List of Water / Sewer Systems contain the PWS ID #, System Name, Subdivisions and Areas Served and Counties (in Alphabetical order). If you are still unsure, please locate the PWS ID # on the upper right of your bill below your account number. This number begins with a "TX" and corresponds with the PWS ID number in the first column of the list of water systems and list of sewer systems.

Step 2: Identify your system codes: Once you have located your water or sewer system on the list of water / sewer systems (pages 5 through 22), identify the Rates Code and Pass-Through Code in the 5th and 6th columns of the systems list. You will need these two codes to calculate the average rate comparisons and average pass-through comparisons. (N/A indicates not applicable). The last column indicates the page number for your rate comparison.

Step 3: Find your rate comparisons (Water and/or Sewer): From Step 1, identify the page for your rate comparison in the last column. Go to the Rate Comparisons pages on pages 32 through 131. These pages compare the current rates to the proposed rates. The first page contains the base facility fee and the volumetric fee comparison, and the second page contains the miscellaneous fees comparisons. A detailed explanation of the fees is below:

- Monthly Minimum and Gallonage Rates: The monthly minimum fee makes up the majority of most customers' bills and, for water, generally recovers the cost of system infrastructure that allows you to turn on your tap at any time and receive water. The gallonage rate generally recovers the variable cost of providing the water you receive and, for most systems, is tiered such that customers who use less water pay less per gallon. Similarly, the wastewater monthly minimum fee recovers the cost of the infrastructure while the wastewater gallonage charge recovers costs that are more variable and depend on actual wastewater flow.
- Pass-throughs: A pass-through rate is a rate added to your monthly bill to recover the cost of purchased water, groundwater district fees or purchased wastewater treatment. The pass-through rate will not change as a result of this filing.
- Miscellaneous Service Fees: Miscellaneous fees are charged only on a case-by-case basis (e.g., returned check charge or meter relocation fee). The Company is requesting the adoption of uniform miscellaneous service fees that will apply to all areas that it serves.

Your current customer bill also includes the following charges:

- Federal Tax Change Credit Rider: This monthly credit from the Federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 has been used to pass savings on to customers. Aqua Texas proposes to eliminate the credit, as the estimated savings previously included in the credit will be captured in the calculation of the proposed monthly minimum and gallonage rates.
- System Improvement Charge (SIC): The system improvement charge (SIC) is a rate based on meter size that is currently added to your monthly bill to recover the cost of system improvements. Aqua Texas proposes to include the current system improvement charge for all systems in the base rate.

Step 4: Calculate the Average Comparison: Rates code and Pass-Through code you identified in Step 2 will allow you to get the average comparisons of your current rates and proposed rates at usage rates 5,000 gallons and 10,000 gallons per month. Identify the Rates Code you found in Step 2 and locate the code on the average comparison pages 23-29. This code is below the current rate averages. Identify the appropriate line. This comparison does not include the Pass-Through charges. The Pass-Through charges can be found by identifying the Pass-Through code from Step 2 and locating the appropriate line on the pass-through comparison pages (pages 30-31). The last two columns contain the average comparison for 5,000 gallons and 10,000 gallons for the pass-through component of your bill. This number will need to be added to the average comparison from above to get the total average comparison at 5,000 gallons and 10,000 gallons of monthly average usage.
