has filed a rate change application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission or PUCT). The application may be reviewed online at interchange.puc.texas.gov. You may also inspect a copy of the rate change application at your utility's office at the address below or at the Commission's office (1701 N. Congress Ave, Austin, TX 78701). The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. If the Commission receives a sufficient number of protests, separately or in a combined protest letter, from at least 7,897 ratepayers (10 percent of the utility's customers over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction) or from any affected municipality before the 91st day after the proposed effective date, the matter will be set for hearing. To Whom it May Concern:

First of all, I am appalled that you had the audacity to send out a document with 131 pages for your customers to review and figure out their own increase. Obviously, you have assumed, most would not respond, or take the time, to study and review the document. Why couldn't you just simply send it to us regarding how much of an increase we would receive. (Could it be you were just trying to cover your incompetence!)

Then to top it off, I received another letter from Aqua trying to convince me that you have provided high quality reliable services, which is an insult to everyone who resides in The Resort. I have lived in the Resort for almost 4 years and have not heard one good thing about Aqua from neighbors, quite the contrary as indicated below;

- 1) Poor water quality
- 2) Severe fluctuations with water pressure
- 3) Water curtailment or restrictions when water is abundant.
- 4) Wells that were to be drilled to increase water volume only to find that permits were not approved.
- 5) Lack of water storage facilities (Tanks).
- 6) Tanks increasing volume installed, only to find out that the pumping system is inadequate.

In closing, I would urge you to reconsider your proposed increase. I, as many others, that reside in the Resort are retired and live on a fixed income. Your proposal, if approved, Will force many of us to reconsider our place of retirement and will consider selling our home, as many are currently doing, or considering the same notion.
