Dear Representative,

I am contacting you on the matter of Aqua Texas rate increase for Lakes of Rosehill, Cypress, TX.

We received a packet that gave the new rates for our neighborhood. The increase went from a flat rate of \$3.70 per 1000 gallons to a tiered system:

Tier 1 - 1-5000 gallons \$5.498

Tier 2 - 5000-10,000 gallons \$8.247

Tier 3 - 10,000-20,000 gallons \$13.745

Tier 4 – over 20,000 gallons \$15.120

This would cause a typical summer water bill for our neighborhood to more than double. These proposed fees are excessive. There is no valid reason for an increase of over 99%.

Our neighborhood has lots from ½ to 1 acre and everyone has automatic irrigation systems to maintain lawns and expensive landscaping. We are very frugal with water use but during warm months we need to use quantities from Tier 3 to Tier 4 to keep our yard alive. Even during the drought a few years back we only watered on specific days as requested by Aqua.

In addition the homes in the neighborhood range from 3000-5000sqft. A family of 4 most likely uses water at least in the range of Tier 3. Water bills that are this excessive will dramatically affect the home values and make it near impossible to ever sell our homes as prospective buyers would not be willing to pay the huge price for water.

This rate increase is more than excessive and we are adamantly against this rate increase.
