has filed a rate change application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission or PUCT). The application may be reviewed online at interchange.puc.texas.gov. You may also inspect a copy of the rate change application at your utility's office at the address below or at the Commission's office (1701 N. Congress Ave, Austin, TX 78701). The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. If the Commission receives a sufficient number of protests, separately or in a combined protest letter, from at least 7,897 ratepayers (10 percent of the utility's customers over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction) or from any affected municipality before the 91st day after the proposed effective date, the matter will be set for hearing. PUC,

I am contacting you on the matter of a proposed Aqua Texas rate increase for Lakes of Rosehill Subdivision (CCN No. 13203) located in Cypress, Texas.

We have received an information packet from Aqua Texas detailing the proposed new rates and the switch from a flat rate of \$3.70 per 1000/gallons to a tiered rate structure as follows:

Tier 1; 1 - 5000 gals \$5.498

Tier 2; 5000 - 10,000 gals \$8.247

Tier 3; 10,000-20,000 gals. \$13.745

Tier 4; over 20,000 gals. \$15.120

The proposed increase is astronomical and there is no justification for an increase of this magnitude. I own a civil engineering company who represents municipal utility districts, so I am very familiar with the cost to pump, treat and distribute water and it is nowhere near the proposed rates. Furthermore, there is no justification for the massive increases proposed for each tier. Aqua Texas has done a poor job of providing an adequate water supply over the years as evidenced by the multiple boil water notices issued for the subdivision. Most of them appear to have been caused by undersized components (wells, booster pumps and ground storage tanks) and improper maintenance (uninsulated plant piping that froze and generators that would not start during power outages).

CCN No. 13203 is within the North Harris County Regional Water Authority's Groundwater Reduction Plan and passes the NHCRWA pumpage fees on to its customers. The NHCRWA has reduced their rates by \$1.00 per 1000 gallons over the past 18 months but Aqua Texas does not have appeared to pass those savings on to us. Additionally, the NHCRWA has designed and will be extending its surface water lines to the Aqua Texas water plants in 2026. While this will result in higher NHCRWA fees, it will also reduce the pumpage from the Aqua Texas wells. The NHCRWA has designed and will be converting the disinfection system at the water plants from chlorine to chloramines at the NHCRWA's expense so Aqua Texas will not be experiencing any capital outlay for this change.

I am not implying that Aqua Texas is not entitled to some increase in their rates, but the proposed increase is more than excessive, and I believe that any reasonable person would agree.
