Why Aqua Texas Should Not Receive a Rate Increase

Aqua Texas has shown to be a poor provider of our potable water in our subdivision. The quality of our water is sub-standard and frequently has the smell of chemicals. The deliver is punctuated with frequent outages, and their customer service is both rude and unresponsive. I reported to their on-site personnel that there was a small water leak on the street side of their water lines and they just ignored it. Aqua Texas has repeatedly been given rate increases that they didn't deserve. Their water rates are already too high.

There was a leak for a long time at the water storage tank that Aqua Texas knew about. The constant runoff across the adjacent home owner's property posed a plethora of significant problems for the homeowner. The homeowner, out of frustration, just sold their home and moved out of our subdivision.

Agua Texas's poor service doesn't deserve a rate increase.
