ORDER NO. 3 GRANTING GOOD CAUSE EXCEPTION FOR LATE-FILED APPLICATION

On June 27, 2025, Tenaska Power Services Co. filed an application to amend its option 2 retail electric provider (REP) certificate number 10035. Tenaska Power seeks the amendment to reflect the deletion of a customer.

On July 25, 2025, Tenaska Power filed a request for a good cause exception to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.107(h)(2), which requires a REP to apply to amend its certification within ten working days from the occurrence of a material change to its certification. Tenaska Power submitted its application on June 27, 2025, and stated the changes were effective on June 9, 2025. Tenaska Power provided an explanation regarding the delay in filing a material change amendment and the steps implemented to avoid future delays in filing material change information in accordance with the deadline in 16 TAC § 25.107(h)(2). On August 15, 2025, Commission Staff filed its recommendation that Tenaska Power's request for a good cause exception be granted.

The ALJ finds good cause exists under 16 TAC § 25.3 and grants an exception to the tenday deadline in 16 TAC § 25.107(h)(2).
